- 3) The text can be composed in Co-authorship, in this sense they can be in possession of a degree in progress, be graduates, or Master's, Master's, Doctorate, Doctorate and similar;

- 5) The Article must be sent to the following e-mail address: revistadcp@gmail.com, in accordance with the Model File with E-mail for the Submission of Articles (Annex I Notice), and the text sent in Word format must be attached and without identification;
- The submission of the Article must be accompanied by a duly signed Term of Copyright Statement (available above) (Annex II Notice);
- 7) The Scientific Article must be unpublished, i.e., not have been previously published by any media;
- 8) There is no limit to the number of articles submitted per author;
- 9) Responsibility for the content of the Article shall lie entirely with the Author;
 - 10) The language, format and format of the Scientific Article.

- 11) Articles can be submitted in Portuguese, English and Spanish. When it is in our language, the wording of the article must be in accordance with the rules of the New Orthographic Agreement of the Portuguese Language;
- 12) The article should be between 15 and 50 pages;
- 13) The text editor of the article must be Word: the font used must be Arial 12, line spacing 1.5, margin 3 cm, alignment justified, paragraph entry 1.25;
- 14) The article must have the following sequence: title, name of the author(s), curriculum vitae (this can be the address of the lattes), abstracts (Portuguese, English or Spanish), keywords, Introduction, body of the work and bibliographic reference;
- 15) Summary highlighting objectives, methodologies and synthesis of final considerations;
- 16) References must be presented at the end of the text, in alphabetical order of the first letter of the Author's Last Name, in accordance with the ABNT;
- 17) Quotes of up to three lines should be inserted into the text. Longer quotations should be in a separate paragraph (indent of 4 cm and Arial 10), single-spaced and without quotation marks;
- 18) When the Scientific Article is approved, the Author(s) and Co-Author(s) must indicate in a footnote their title and email address;
- 19) The names of the works should be underlined in bold;

20) Summary of the form and format of the Scientific Articles Submitted.

21) The Scientific Article must follow the following structural molds in terms of shape and format. However, its structure only needs to be composed of: a) Title in Portuguese and in a foreign language, b)

Name(s) of the author(s); (c) Summary in Portuguese and foreign language; (d) Keywords; (e)

Summary; (f) Source: Times New Roman; (g) Source 12; (h) Source 10 for indented citation; (i) Source 10 for footnotes;

22) Evaluation of the articles presented.

23) The Evaluation of the Scientific Articles will be carried out in the double-blind evaluation modality, and 2 (two) Opinions will be issued without mentioning the names of the Author(s) and Co-Authors(s) with the Objection and Evaluation of Criteria that indicate the meritorious improvements, and the Writers must make the adjustments to the required parameters. Evaluation deadlines will always be within six-month periods;

1.4) AREAS AND THEMES OF THE DCP JOURNAL AND ITS RELATIONSHIP WITH THE NEXUS SCIENTIA RESEARCH NETWORK



The Areas end by delimiting the Topics to be sent along with the scientific texts produced, as follows: the Fundamental Areas to the Critical Epistemologies of Law, Culture and Process: 1) Philosophy of Law; 2) Sociology of Law; 3) Theory of Law, 4) Economic Analysis of Law; 5) New Law, Sustainability, Innovation and Technologies; and, 6) New radical, insurgent and decolonial knowledge and epistemologies. In addition, it specifically follows Public Law in the areas: 1) Postmodern, Reflexive, Radical, Insurgent and Decolonial Constitutionalism - between regulation and regulation; (2) Protection and enforcement of constitutional guarantees; (3) Protection and observance of human and fundamental rights; and 4) Procedural Law. On the other hand, it follows the areas of Private Law, namely: 1) Civil Law and Private Law in its postmodern scope -between regulation and regulation-; 2) Organization and Business Law.
